Perennial Crops

The following is correct for California.

- Base period of APH data is 10 consecutive years for all perennial crops except apples which is 5 years.
- Crops have a minimum age and / or production requirement shown below.

Almonds	5 th growing season or 4 th with RO approval	None
Apples	None	10 bins per acre or 250 field boxes in 1 of last 4 years
Avocados	6 th growing season	Must produce 2,000 lbs in 1 of the last 3 years
Blueberries	None	Must produce 1,000 lbs in 1 of the last 3 years
Cherries	None	2,300 lbs per acre in one of the last 4 years
Citrus	6 th growing season 5 th with RO approval	None
Figs	6 th growing season	None
Grapes	4 th year growing season 3 rd year after grafting	2 tons per acre *can be waived with AIP approval
Olives	Table – 5 th growing season	Must have produced at least 2.5 tons per acre in 1 of last 3 years
	Oil – 5 th growing season	Must have produced at least 100 gallons of oil per acre in 1 of last 3 years
Pears	None	5 tons per acre of first grade canning or U.S. No. 1 pears in 1 of 4 preceding crop years
Pistachios	10 th growing season	None
Prunes	7 th growing season	None
Stonefruit	5 th growing season 4 th with RO approval	200 lugs of fresh market production or 2.2 tons per acre for processing types in 1 of last 4 years
Table Grapes	4 th year growing season 3 rd year after grafting	150 lugs per acre
Walnuts	6 th growing season or 5 th with RO approval	None

* Use year set out as 1st growing season **IF** planted prior to July 1st.
